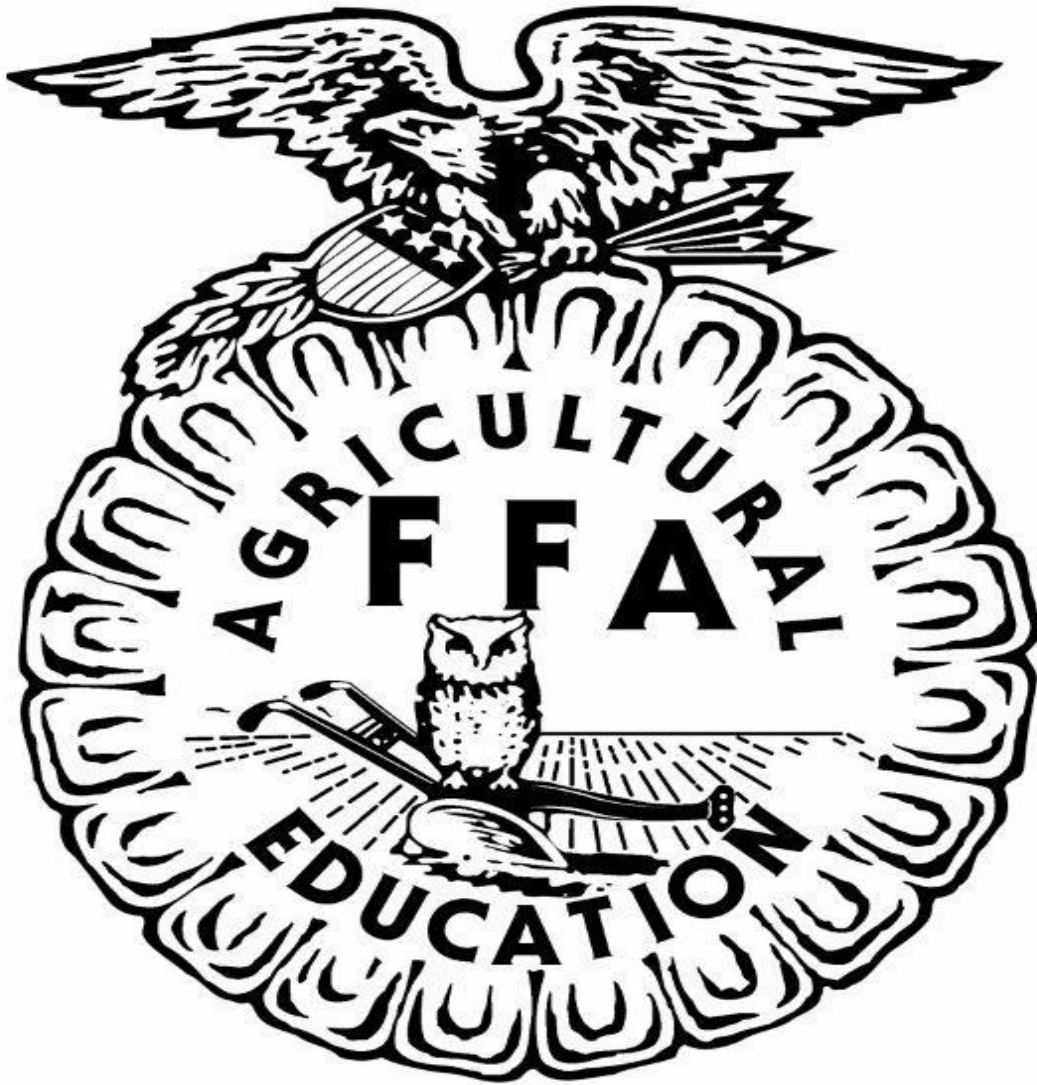

SCHOLARSHIP: MONTGOMERY HIGH SCHOOL FFA BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Rules and Qualifications:

I. The Applicant Must:

- a. Be an active member of the Montgomery High School FFA Chapter and be in good standing.
- b. Have received or met the qualifications to receive the Lone Star Degree.
- c. Be in their senior year at Montgomery High School.
- d. Turn in correctly completed application with all required signatures on time. **Absolutely NO late applications will be considered.**
- f. Maintain a Grade Point Average of a 2.5 at the time the application is submitted and have attached a current MHS transcript.
- g. Must be scheduled to graduate either on-time or early from the year entering ninth grade.

II. Considerations:

- h. Completion of the application for scholarship does not guarantee its award, but if accepted for this scholarship, awardees understand they will not receive the award until they have enrolled in a full-time continuing education program above the high school level.
- i. If accepted for this scholarship, applicants understand they must turn in documentation showing a tuition cost and then a check will be sent directly to the college or institution of learning of your enrollment.

III. Additional Information:

- j. Applicants are to turn in (2) recommendation letters in sealed envelopes from either teachers or community leaders. The persons writing letters of recommendation cannot be related to the applicant in any way and cannot be an ag teacher at Montgomery High School.
- k. The students awarded the Montgomery FFA Booster Club Scholarship will be chosen based on a point system. Points will be tracked by MHS FFA Member and approved by an MHS Ag Teacher.
- l. The amount and number of scholarships awarded annually by the Montgomery High School FFA Booster Club will be determined by the MHS FFA Booster Club Officers, Scholarship Committee, and Members.
